Veterans Day Remember and Honor: Then, Now, Forever
ABMF Director of Military & Veterans Outreach available for interview

DENVER, CO– (Sunday, November 6) - More than 218,000 American service members are buried or memorialized (remains missing) at 26 American military cemeteries and 32 monuments away from the homeland. We are building a network of active-duty military, veterans, their families and those who appreciate their service to tell the stories of those who died in defense of freedom.

Our purpose and focus are reflected in our motto: ABMF – We Remember and Honor: Then, Now, Forever.

We are the American Battle Monuments Foundation, abmf.org, the official non-profit partner of the American Battle Monuments Commission (abmc.gov.) ABMC is the US federal agency charged with maintenance and management of these hallowed sites.

Tom Clark, ABMF Director of Military & Veterans Outreach, is available for interview. Mr. Clark served for 27 years in the U.S. Army. His father served in the U.S. Navy during WWII. Four of his uncles volunteered and fought in WWII. His grandfather served in the U.S. Army in WWI and was wounded in the Battle of Meuse-Argonne.

Clark's assignments included HR Director, Secretary of the Army, Office of the Administrative Assistant; Sergeant Major to the Adjutant General and SGM Deputy Chief of Staff Personnel and Communities, U.S. Army Europe. He is the former executive officer for the American Battle Monuments Commission, Overseas Operations.
